situated among the north cascade mountains of washington state in the glacier peak wilderness area miners ridge contains vast quantities of copper kennecott copper corporation s plan to develop an open pit mine there was when announced in 1966 the first test of the mining provision of the wilderness act passed by congress in 1964 the battle over the proposed open pit big enough to be seen from the moon as activists called it drew the attention of both local and national conservationists who vowed to stop the desecration of one of the west s most scenic places kennecott copper had the full force of the law and mining industry behind it in asserting its extractive rights meanwhile the u s forest service was determined to defend its authority to manage wilderness an open pit visible from the moon tells the story of this historic struggle to define the contours of the wilderness act its possibilities and limits combining rigorous analysis and deft storytelling adam m sowards re creates the contest between kennecott and its shareholders on one hand and activists on the other intent on maintaining wilderness as a place immune to the calculus of profit a host of actors cross these pages from cabinet secretaries and a supreme court justice to local doctors and college students all contributing to a drama that made miners ridge a cause célèbre for the nation s wilderness movement as locals testified at public hearings and writers penned profiles in the nation s magazines and newspapers the volatile political economy of copper proved equally influential in frustrating kennecott s plans no law or court ruling could keep kennecott from mining copper but the pit was never dug identifying the contingent factors and forces that converged and coalesced in this case sowards s narrative recalls a critical moment in the struggle over the nation s wild places even as it puts the unpredictability of history on full display

standing watch at the sacrificial altar in britain the lone druid priest watched the storm build up around him it was the summer equinox and the fullest full moon he had ever seen he d been waiting for what seemed hours within the ring of monolithic rocks feeling the power of the storm grow with each bolt of lightning the

force of energy contained inside the altar seemed to double in strength the young druid could see the flow of blue fire as it passed from upright column to the next a ring of horrendous force beyond anything he has ever seen being an eight level master but only twenty five years old he hadn t had much time to do anything he d been tutored by the last of the great masters all level twelve s as well as being well past the hundred year mark they stood facing him now their backs to each of the tall support posts one for each of the twelve massive blocks of granite which made up the druidical circle they now stood in

ritual performance and media are significant areas of study which are essential to anthropology and are often surprisingly overlooked this book brings a more anthropological perspective to debates about media consumption performativity and the characteristics of spectacle which have transformed cultural studies over the past decade

this anthology is one volume from c j s hayward s collected works it includes a visit from the archdruid of canterbury to an orthodox patriarch a glimpse of the eighth sacrament a look at whether we need to think in terms of rights a look at artwork in the shadow of iconography a look at the crown of thorns we need to grow a meditation on eternity and time kairos and chronos and the story of a young college student whose world grows deeper when he finds a storybook telling the legends of king arthur the enchanted and enchanting forest brocéliande and the great quest for the holy grail book jacket

originally published in 1977 the pioneer critics of finnegans wake hailed the work as a radical critique of language and civilization resuming their position margot norris explains the book s most intractable uncertainties not as puzzles to be solved by a clever reader but as manifestations of a chaosmos a freudian dream world of sexual transgression and social dissolution of inauthentic being and empty words conventional moralities and restraints are under siege in this chaosmos where precisely those desires and forbidden wishes that are barred in waking thought strive to make themselves felt norris demonstrates convincingly that the protean characters of finnegans wake are the creatures of a dreaming mind the teleology of their universe is freedom and in the enduring struggle between the individual s anarchic psyche and the laws that make civilization possible it is only in dream that the psyche is triumphant it is as dream rather than as novel that norris reads

finnegans wake the lexical deviance and semantic density of the book norris argues are not due to joyce s malice mischief or megalomania but are essential and intrinsic to his concern to portray man s inner state of being because meanings are dislocated hidden in unexpected places multiplied and split given over to ambiguity plurality and uncertainty the wake norris claims represents a decentered universe its formal elements of plot character discourse and language are not anchored to any single point of reference they do not refer back to center only by abandoning conventional frames of reference can readers allow the work to disclose its own meanings which are lodged in the differences and similarities of its multitudinous elements eschewing the close explication of much wake criticism the author provides a conceptual framework for the work s large structures with the help of theories and methods borrowed from freud heidegger lacan levi strauss and derrida looking at the work without novelistic expectations of the illusion of some key to unlock the mystery norris explores joyce s rationale for committing his last human panorama a bit sadder than ulysses in its concern with aging killing and dying to a form and language belonging to the deconstructive forces of the twentieth century

the author of ireland s holy wars journeys through the celtic world to discover the celtic past and what remains of the authentic culture today discovering that celtic revival is largely misplaced and that the threats to the world s celtic communities and culture are relentless

in the wake of the cataclysm conflict has engulfed every corner of azeroth hungering for more resources amid the turmoil the horde has pressed into ashenvale to feed its burgeoning war machine there acting warchief garrosh hellscreech has employed a brutal new tactic to conquer the region original

night birds reign the high king is dead and the land is in peril a child has been born to save his people but a traitor lurks with murder in his heart dogging the footsteps of those who protect the babe who would be king but high magic is at work when gwydion the dreamer awakes the shining ones entrust him with protecting young arthur and locating the high king s lost sword a woman holds the key to unlock a horrible secret fighting assassins to find her gwydion sets out upon his odyssey and finds that fate cannot be fulfilled without sacrificing the life of someone he loves crimson fire the lone survivor of a shipwreck gives birth and dies so begins a cycle of events that will end in a tragic war when havgan of corania becomes warleader of corania he sets the might of the empire against kymru gwydion the dreamer dreams of the coming destruction of his country and the deaths of those he loves he seeks out rhiannon in a race against time to save kymru and escape corania alive cry of sorrow havgan seeks to proclaim himself high king of kymru dogged by havgan s soldiers gwydion the dreamer and his family face a difficult journey made even harder by the distrust they have for each other arthur risks his life and his very soul in the deadly game may earth rise the y dawnus the gifted are high king arthur s early medieval society living in a mysterious land in 500 a d the dreamers the dewin the druids and the bards these chosen ones are his talented pillars without them his empire cannot survive cruel deprivation and a full scale conflict bring the y dawnus to the brink of annihilation confronting his mortal enemy havgan the warleader arthur and his forces must fight a formidable opponent backed by menacing powers that threaten to end their magical elite kingdom

in this conclusion to a powerful saga cruel deprivation and a full scale conflict bring the y dawnus to the brink of annihilation in the land of kymru high king arthur has designated the talented pillars of society as the gifted these gifted peoples are essential to his empire when they are taken captive by the corianans king arthur

confronts his mortal enemy havgan the warleader a formidable opponent backed by menacing powers that threaten to end the magic in kymru forced to enter a treacherous realm where captives are collared and sacrificed where ruthless territorial boundaries are drawn and enforced and where death by poisoning and torture are the norm king arthur and those loyal to him must fight to save their way of life and to liberate the gifted in this captivating and stirring fantasy only the strongest survive in the pursuit of freedom only the deepest passion will drive away the evil that lurks in this mystical land of fragile kingdoms powerful warlords and ancient magic

the roman armies are conquering britain they have destroyed the druid sanctuaries and savagely crushed boudicca s revolt in these desperate days knowing his own death is imminent the last archdruid of ynys mon engenders a son the boy s mission to defeat the roman invaders and preserve his father s heritage but can he possibly survive long enough to achieve his goal

ireland 279 bc a nation at war for two boys it will be gruelling for ireland it will be bloody when the first raiding skirmishes of a foreign army are crushed and ireland mourns her dead one king knows their newfound peace is destined to fail as overking of ailigh keeper of the north he calls for the boys of his celtic tribes to train as formidable warriors under his command for Áed it begins as a fantastical quest for rónán it helps him escape a cruel chieftain together they must train and grow in strength and might and when the invading army returns a nation goes to war united under one banner meanwhile Áed s sister begins her training as a druid learning the spiritual ways of the earth and when the goddess cáer speaks to her in her dreams she knows that ireland s future hangs in the balance with Áed skilled in close combat and rónán blessed with an archer s eye they fight side by side champions of the celts but death is close and the tides of war are forever in flux the irish celts know one thing if the warmongering foreigners aren t defeated not even the druids can change the course of destiny
