with more than 200 colour plates and for the first time available as a study in english this volume explores the vast heritage of korean ink brush painting providing a rich panorama of information that stretches across the entire spectrum of korean art including painting pottery calligraphy and literature which will have wide appeal not least to art lovers and students of korean studies part i presents the material in essay form part ii which uses a dictionary format summarizes the information in part i and highlights the hidden messages and symbolism inherent in literati ink brush painting in korea when china and japan opened up to outside influence in the nineteenth century korea maintained a closed door policy becoming known as the hermit kingdom only to be swallowed up in the struggle for hegemony between the great powers annexation by japan in 1910 threatened korea s language and culture with extinction liberation in 1945 was followed by the tragedy of the korean war in 1950 in the period of reconstruction after the korean war artists and scholars faced the task of retrieving korea s endangered cultural tradition ink brush painting is a unique part of this tradition its history stretches back through the choson dynasty when chinese influences were assimilated and absorbed and made into korea s distinctive tradition

included mrs lydia sigourney hannah f gould and julia c r dorr by 1851 each issue published a peice of music and two steel plates usually landscapes or portraits when davis e clark took over the editorship in 1853 the magazine became brighter and attained a circulation of 40 000 unlike his predecessors clark included fictional pieces and made the repository a magazine for the whole family after the war it began to decline and in 1876 was replaced by the national repository the ladies repository was an excellent representative of the methodist mind and heart its essays sketches and poems its good steel engravings and its moral tone gave it a charm all its own cf american periodicals 1741 1900

the essays in this volume focus on the historical institutional and ritual context of a number of japanese buddhist paintings sculptures calligraphies and relics some celebrated others long overlooked

chikamatsu monzaemon 1653 1725 often referred to as japan s shakespeare and a god of writers was arguably the most famous playwright in japanese history and wrote more than 100 plays for the kabuki and bunraku theaters today the plays of this major literary figure are performed on kabuki and bunraku stages as well as in the modern theater and forty nine films of his plays have been made thirty one of them from the silent era translations of chikamatsu s plays are available but we have few examples of his late work in which he increasingly incorporated stylistic elements of his shorter contemporary dramas into his longer period pieces translator c andrew gerstle argues that in these mature history plays chikamatsu depicted the tension between the private and public spheres of society by combining the rich character development of his contemporary pieces with the larger political themes of his period pieces in this volume gerstle translates five plays four histories and one contemporary piece never before available in english that complement other collections of chikamatsu s work revealing new dimensions to the work of this great japanese playwright and artist

in this work daniel prokop examines the description of the pillars in 1 kgs 7 15 22 he analyzes extrabiblical parallels greek and hebrew textual witnesses as well as iconography and archaeological finds and asks about the symbolic meaning of the columns

the so called book of two ways is a long and complex composition containing both texts and images it reached us on the insides of some coffins and tomb walls principally from the hermapolitan nome in the egyptian middle kingdom 2055 1650 bc wael sherbiny presents a pioneering study based on all the original and hitherto unpublished sources through hermapolitan lenses challenges many of the traditional views related to this composition as part of the coffin texts it also provides an integrated pictorial and textual analysis revealing many unprecedented facts the oldest and longest leather manuscript from ancient egypt the cairo leather roll which sherbiny rediscovered during his study and soon became world news features here for the first time as well
